Dance Committee

It's already March and we are well into our dance schedule for 2012. I would like to begin by thanking **Kenn and Shug Ward** for teaching the January beginner class and February intermediate class, **Dinky Slaughter and Barbara White** for teaching the February beginner class, and **Sid Strawderman and Jane Renger** for teaching the January intermediate class. Thanks also go to **Carolyn Reade**. **Sharon Moody**, and **Sue Moore** for January and February line dances.

The dance instructors recently met to discuss the dance schedule, class content, and how to bring new instructors into the schedule. We also discussed suggestions that were submitted from members for consideration.

Let me give you an overview of our dance class program and what you can expect this year.

RSC currently has 19 scheduled shag class instructors. Together, they will provide 44 beginner classes, 36 intermediate classes, 12 "special" classes (new material), and 11 shag jams (also new material). According to my math, that's 103 shag classes for 2012!

Beginner classes are held each Thursday from March through November. Intermediate classes are on Tuesdays March through November, *except* for April and September. "Special" classes (new material) will be held on the fifth Tuesdays and Thursdays of these months. In addition, a Sunday Shag Jam is held once a month. If classes are moving along quickly or students are already familiar with the material, instructors will be providing variations to the scheduled step or ways to incorporate the step in their dancing.

In addition, RSC offers line dances on the first and third Tuesday of each month with the exception of April and September. That means **18 line dance lessons** each year. Most of these classes are taught by Carolyn Reade.


