After much discussion and deliberation, the board subsequently decided this increase was necessary. This is the first increase in the club's dues in twenty five years. Our club is very fortunate to have a place to dance without the cost of building rentals, DJ cost, etc. Some clubs have found themselves without a place to dance and have undergone tremendous changes in their membership due to ever-increasing demand for operating funds. We have a very strong club and hopefully we will remain so. We are indeed fortunate but that could change tomorrow.

The John Mansini Golf Tournament on June 4th, 2012 is coming together due to the hard work of Leonard McAdams, Dickie Robinson and some dedicated individuals. We still need hole sponsorships and golf teams. Remember this is our club's big fund raiser for our charity, Camp Fantastic. This is a summer camp for kids with cancer or recovering from cancer.
