## **Vice President**

I was rummaging through some stuff the other day when an old, tucked away newspaper article grabbed my attention. **SHAGGING** is what the title screamed,

in a bold, thick font. I seem to remember that **Dickie Robinson** gave it to me several years ago during one of my terms as your president.

The article, written by Lisa Crutchfield, was featured in the August 31, 1989 WEEKEND section of the Richmond News Leader (remember when we had an afternoon paper?). It was all about the Carolina Shag, the enthusiasm of the dancers, and the relatively new Richmond Shag Club, which began unofficially in 1985, but was sanctioned by the ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Clubs) in October of 1987. This made us certifiable, official and proper.

The 542 members danced two nights a week, Wednesday and Friday, at DJ's Lounge, which was located at the intersection of Warwick Road and Midlothian Pike, not too far from Vision's, where we dance today.

There are two photos in the article, one pictures a group of about 20 line dancers, (none I recognize), and the other is of a couple shaggers identified as Mikki Knight and Ed Ely. Anyone remember them? Members mentioned are instructors Pat Henson, a Lifetime RSC member and an inductee of the Virginia Shaggers Hall of Fame, Earl Robinson, a Lifetime RSC member, as well a member of both the Virginia and National Shagger's Hall of Fame, and an ACSC Icon Award and Living Legends Honoree and **Shirley Porter** (Gough). also a Lifetime RSC member, a Virginia Shaggers Hall of Famer, and club past President. Lessons were held on Wednesday nights, beginning at 8. The DJ was, and still is, Cliff Merritt, a member of the Virginia Shaggers Hall of Fame. Annual dues were \$25, and there were cover charges for non-members of \$2 on Wednesday and \$3 on Friday.
