

A CHALLENGE TO THE RSC MEMBERSHIP

I personally am very proud that the Richmond Shag Club not only has historically chosen Camp Fantastic (CF) as our charity of choice but that we are also the largest CF contributor in the Richmond metro area. For those new to the club, CF is a one week summer camp, located in the Northern Shenandoah Valley, for children with cancer. CF has never turned a child away no matter what their medical needs may be. Many oncologists, medical specialists, technicians, nurses and volunteers sacrifice a week's vacation every year to provide their time and services for these children during this week of camp. After spending most of their young lives, in many cases, in hospitals dealing with treatments, surgeries, IV's, amputations and injections trying to address this horrible disease, CF provides them with an opportunity to just be children. This is a rare occurrence for many of them.

The RSC generates revenue for this worthwhile endeavor in several ways. First, the majority of the funds donated by the RSC to CF come from the after-expense proceeds of our annual charity golf tournament. Second, the monies raised through a silent auction held at our annual party is our second largest source of CF funds. One hundred percent of all proceeds from the golf tournament and the auction go into the Club escrow account for our annual CF donation. Third, some winners of our weekly 50-50 drawings give their winnings back and ask that they be included in our annual donation to CF. Finally, some members make direct donations to the Club earmarked for CF. All of these sources combined contributed to a \$16,100 RSC donation in 2015. Additionally some members make charitable donations to CF in memory of a deceased RSC member at the decedent's request.

As I did last year, I will be heading up the "Donations Committee", responsible for hole sponsors and raffle gift donations for our 2016 golf tournament, and I have a 3-part challenge for all 350+ RSC members.....



Consider entering a team in the tourna-

ment. We need up to 112 golfers to play to reach the goal of 28 teams. The cost to play is \$100 per player or \$400 for a foursome. If you don't play personally, talk to your family members, neighbors, people you work with or go to church with who do. Tell them of this great opportunity to help this worthy cause and have fun at the same time. Generate enough interest that they will be more than glad to sign up and participate.

Consider sponsoring a hole. The cost for sponsoring a hole this year will be \$100, as it has always been. For your \$100 donation, you will get a sign at one of the 18 holes that recognizes your sponsorship. A large number of our hole sponsors are local businesses or corporations. We all have grocery stores, restaurants, doctors, dentists, gas stations, car washes, bowling alleys, hair salons/barbers, landscapers, auto parts stores, department stores, etc. that we use on a regular basis. Tell them about Camp Fantastic and what wonderful work they do there. Tell them how their money will be used to send a child with cancer to camp. Some sponsors use this opportunity as a memorial to a loved one. I don't know of any family who has not been touched by cancer, for instance. Also, in the past, a few couples or 4 or 5 individuals have gone together and split the cost of sponsoring a hole. Quite a few RSC members have done this in the past.





A CHALLENGE TO THE RSC MEMBER-SHIP...continued

Help us solicit and collect gifts for the after-

tournament raffle. Restaurants and other businesses are famous for donating gift cards. Free oil changes, meals, free rounds of golf, golf lessons as well as manicures/pedicures/ hair cuts immediately come to mind. Some businesses love to donate swag such as shirts, golf balls, hats and coozies with their logos as well. Some RSC members have also purchased and donated golf balls, wine and/or gift certificates (e.g. Lowes, Home Depot, Applebees, etc.) as gifts for the raffle in the past...

For these various donations, my past personal experience has demonstrated that all you have to do is ask. It's as simple as that. For gift donations, ask to speak to the manager of the $\mathcal{D}oug$ business. Don't go during their busy time though. Lunch and dinner times at Outback or another popular restaurant would be a bad 2016 RSC Golf Tournament Donations Committee idea. Be familiar with and have all the forms Chair and info about Camp Fantastic and the golf tournament (available at the RSC desk or RSC

web site) on hand and present them to the person in charge. You will be surprised at how many will say "Yes".

So that is my personal challenge to all 350+ Richmond Shaq Club members. Pick one, two or all three challenges above! Participate in some shape or form and help us make the RSC Golf Tournament a bigger success than it has been in years past. You will be providing a child with cancer and their family a tremendous service and that has to make you smile!!!
